How did you come to work at Aon?

I was new to brokerage, I was not part of a team, and I had to deal with the heartbreak and anguish of what I witnessed that day, including the loss of dear friends and co-workers. The year that followed after 9/11 was truly the most difficult year in my career. I had to remain strong and work through feelings of survivor's guilt. I was forced to focus my energy on learning the Kidnap, Commercial Crime, Financial Institution Bond coverages and building relationships with clients and underwriters during a hard market.

What piece of advice would you give to other women in the industry?

Stay focused on your own career and do not let yourself be distracted by what is happening with the career paths of others. Everyone has a different path; some take longer to reach their career goals than others but hard work and dedication will eventually pay off.

People would be surprised to know... I was very shy when I started at Aon. People who know me today but didn't know me back then will be shocked when they hear this.

Did you have a female role model that inspires/inspired you in your career?
